£ The church treasurers present at the meeting gave a brief update on church finances.

£ Churches will be asked to provide an overview of their finances for the next circuit meeting.

Funds for Chapel Sales

£ The circuit meeting on 14 November discussed three proposed projects from Stokesley, Carlton and Seamer:

☪☪☪ Stokesley requested further funds to complete vital repair work to ensure the continued mission of the church.

☪☪☪ Carlton requested funds to refurbish their kitchen for current users and in order to offer a community lunch.

☪☪☪ Seamer requested funds to cover essential repair work to maintain their presence in the community.

£ The total set aside for mission projects was £109k. In the September meeting £20k was allocated to urgent repairs to Stokesley Church. Leaving £80k to be allocated.

£ The meeting agreed to allocate Seamer Chapel £3k for urgent repairs. Decisions on the Stokesley and Carlton projects were deferred to the March meeting.
